Their work being hampered by lack of a satisfactory geological map, the writer was instructed by the Quebec Department of Mines to revise the previous information and to prepare a new detailed map and report. Two months and a half were spent in the field in the summer of 1910, during which time a careful micrometer and compass survey was made of the rock exposures in the portion of the township found to be the most favourable for prospecting. Since previous work in other districts had shown that the silver-bearing ores are closely associated with the newer diabase, the area covered by detailed work was confined to the vicinity of the occurrences of the diabase, so that...
